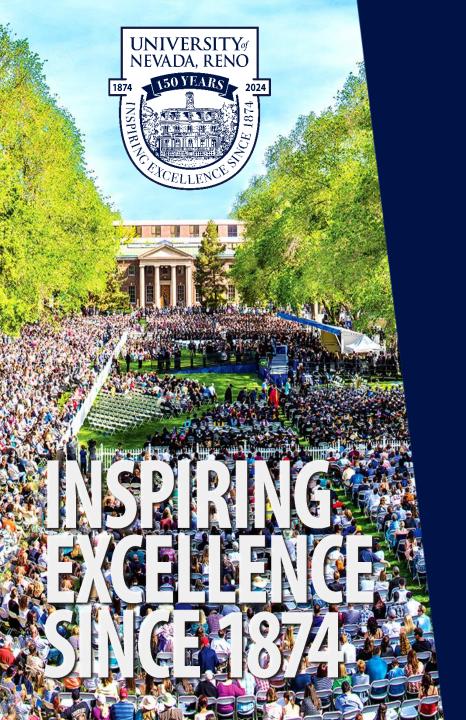




#### Framing the Conversation

- FY 2024 Budget Shortfall
  - 12% COLA Funding Gap
  - Student Fee Shortfall
  - Other Projected Shortfalls
  - Budget Reduction Solutions
- FY 2025 Budget Shortfall
  - Legislature Approved Budget
  - 12% + 11% COLA Funding Gap
  - Student Fee Shortfall
  - FY 2025 COLA Funding Options



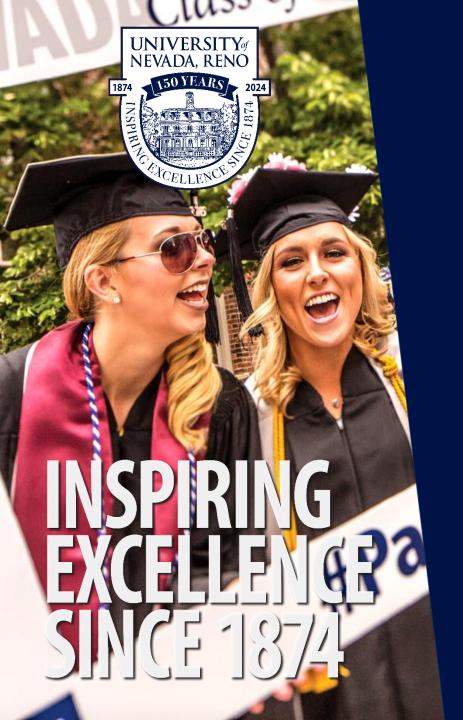


#### **FY 24 Budget Shortfall**

- Cost of 12% COLA for Faculty & Staff: \$27.1M
- 60.5% State COLA Funding Allocation: \$16.4M
- 12% COLA Funding Shortfall: \$10.7M
- Lower than Projected Enrollment: \$8.5M
- Net Increase in Expenses: \$1.7M
- Projected Utility Shortfall: \$4.5M

Net FY 24 Shortfall: \$25.4M

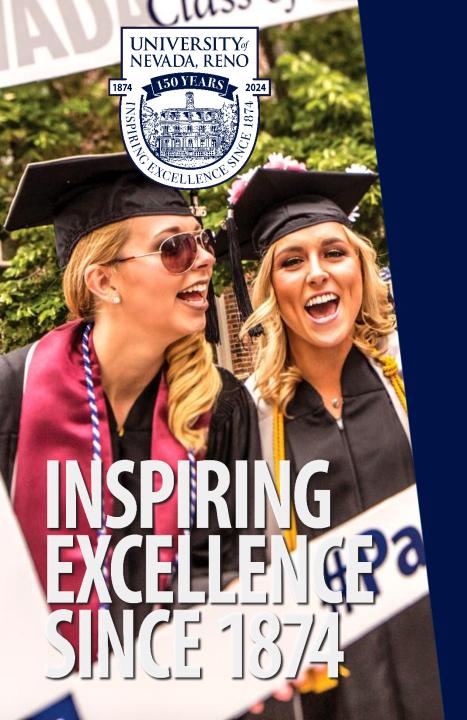




#### **FY 24 Budget Solutions**

Description	FY 2024
5% Budget Reductions	\$11.1M
Reallocation of F&A Funds	\$5.0M
Administrative Overhead Charge	\$5.0M
Anticipated Vacancy Savings	\$5.0M
Total	\$26.1M

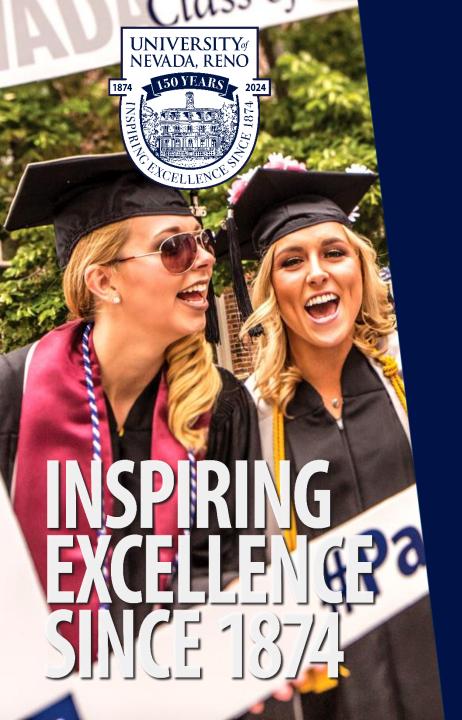




#### FY 24 – 5% Reduction Summary

Description	FY 2024
<b>Hold Positions Vacant</b>	\$6.2M
Reallocate to Non-State Funds	\$2.0M
Reduce Operating Costs	\$0.9M
Reduce Graduate Assistants	\$0.1M
Reduce Letters of Appointment	\$1.2M
Reduce Hourly Staff	\$0.2M
Sub-Total	\$10.6M

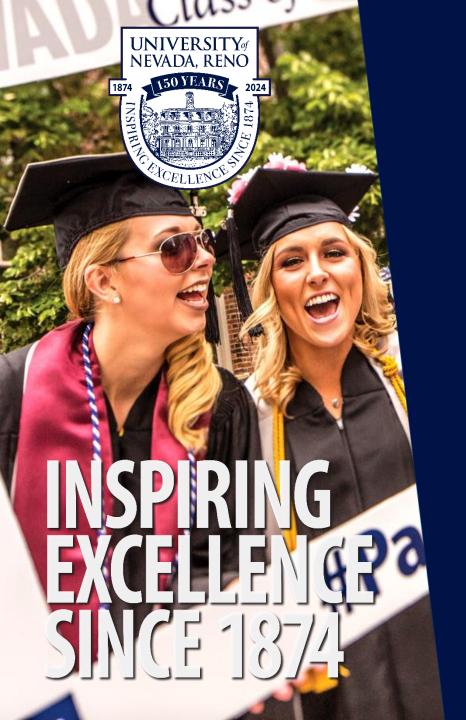

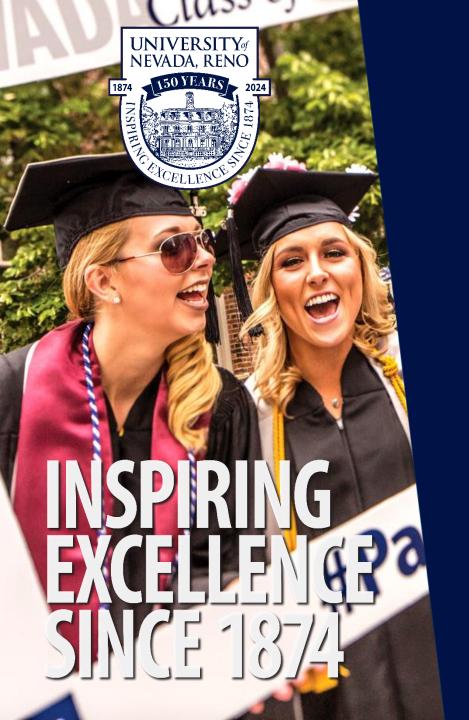

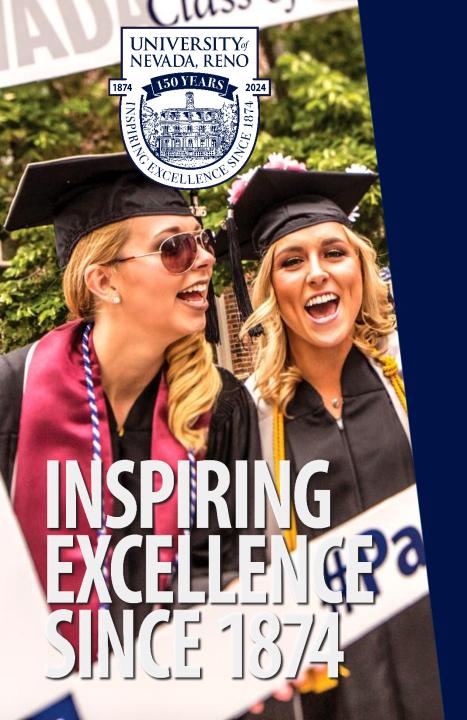

Total	\$11.1M

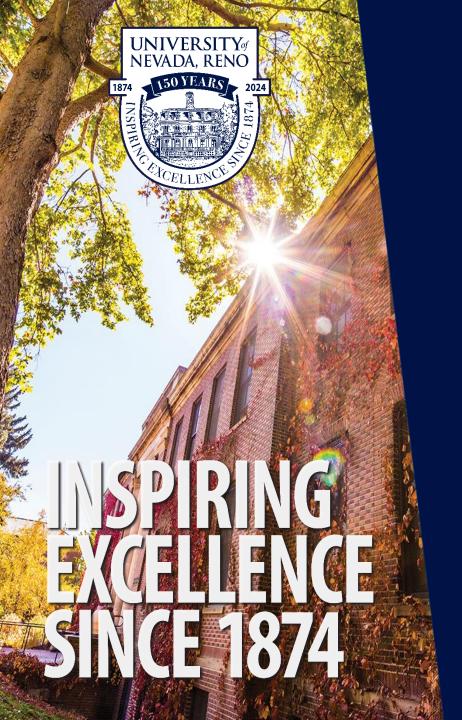


#### **FY 25 State Funding**

Description	FY 2025
Base Budget	\$131.4M
<b>Budget Restorations</b>	\$7.6M
<b>Graduate Assistant Stipends &amp; Positions</b>	\$3.6M
Summer Teacher Education Program	\$0.1M
UNR @ Lake Tahoe	\$0.8M
Total	\$143.6M

- 10.6% increase over FY 23 budget
- Funds MUST be spent on approved items





#### **FY 25 Budget Shortfall**

- 12% COLA Funding Shortfall: \$10.7M
- 11% COLA Funding Shortfall: \$11.0M
- Lower than Projected Enrollment: \$10M

Net FY 25 Shortfall: \$31.7M





#### **Options Being Discussed**

**NSHE Committee to Recommend Board Action on FY 2025 Salary Increases** 

Budget Cuts

Every 1% Cut Saves: \$2.6M

Reduced COLA for Faculty

Every 1% Reduction Saves: \$2M

Increased Student Fees

Every 1% Increase Generates: \$1.2M

- Delayed Start of 11% COLA for Faculty
- Temporary Student Fee Increase
